Boadzulu Island or more commonly known as Bird Island is the most southern part of Lake Malawi's National Park and part of the world heritage site, host to the biggest breeding colony of White Breasted Cormorants in Southern Africa.

Its water are crystal clear and the presence of the multi colored Mbuna fish provides a surpassing beauty that makes the island one of the best for snorkeling and swimming.

Alternatively, explore the island which offers a peaceful and romantic setting for sundowners. Come and watch the fish eagles feed, while fisherman from the villages along the shore line make their way on their nightly fishing expeditions. All of this is done while watching the African sun fall behind the horizon, casting a remarkable reflection of colors on the Lakes waters.
